Constitutive session July 2009



Martin Schulz, President-elect of the Group of the Progressive Alliance of Socialists and Democrats, has pledged himself to a more democratic, more social, fairer and more open Europe during the new parliamentary term.

Mr Schulz also singled out improving the European Parliament's image and stressed the need for efforts to ensure that the EP becomes more high-profile and allows European citizens to see and understand what we do. In the face of mounting extremism, the S-D Group, he indicated, must fight to guarantee respect for minorities and for the protection of human dignity.
