From the vast number of nominations the Jury, composed of MEPs and representatives of major trade unions and civil society organisations, selected six awardees in several categories.

This year's winners are:

BUILDING LEARNING SOCIETIES

L'Ecole Laïque du chemin des dunes Calais, France

An improvised school that provided education to minors and adults that were living in the refugee encampment in Calais, also wrongly called "the jungle".

SPECIAL JURY AWARD

Antoine Deltour

Mr. Deltour is the whistle blower behind the Lux Leaks who was sentenced to 12 months of jail for disclosing illegal fiscal practices. After different appeals that confirmed his sentence he is now considering to apply to the European Court of Human Rights.

TOGETHER FOR SOCIAL EUROPE

The Soledad Cazorla Prieto Fund, Spain

The Fund supports the personal development and studies of children who lost their mother as a consequence of domestic and gender violence.

National Union of Workers Producers Co-operatives (NUWPC), Bulgaria

The NUWPC's mission is to help people with disabilities to take part in the social economy. The model of cooperatives is built on social and democratic values and intends to contribute to the well-being of both society as the lives of their employees.
