Whitewashing of the anti-European extreme right in the EU Gaby Bischoff, S&D Vice President

The state of democracy in the EU is fragile and worrying. Some member states, like Orbán's Hungary, have become autocracies, and in others, pro-fascist parties are making their way into government. The European People's Party used to believe in the common interest of the European Union as a whole. Today, the EPP is embracing the far right and endorsing dangerous nationalism. The conservatives are normalising and supporting the extreme right's efforts to enter European institutions. They support political leaders that flirt with Putin. EU-Western Balkans relations in light of new enlargement package

Russian aggression towards Ukraine must be a wake-up call for us all: enlargement must once again become an EU geopolitically strategic policy after several years of fatigue. This past year has only given us a single piece of good news regarding the Western Balkans enlargement process: the opening of accession negotiations with Albania and the conditional opening with North Macedonia. Now it is high time to further the enlargement process with other countries. For example, EU member states should finally adopt a visa-free regime for the citizens of Kosovo. But any country aspiring to join the EU must make a clear pro-European choice too - to align with European values and foreign policy. If Serbia wants to progress on its EU path, it must stop making a mockery of democracy, reverse its wilful destruction of the rule of law, and align with the EU sanctions against Russia.
